CONDITIONS OF LICENSE

1. Any change in the technical staff named in the license shall be forthwith reported to the licensing authority.
2. The license shall be deemed to extend to such additional items as the license may intimate to the licensing authority from time to time, and may be endorsed by the licensing authority.
3. The licensee shall inform the licensing authority in writing in the event of any change in the constitution of the firm operating under license, where any change in the constitution of the firm takes place, the current license shall be deemed to be valid for a maximum period of three months from the date on which change takes place unless, in the meantime a fresh license has been taken from the licensing authority in the name of the firm with the changed constitute.
4. The license unless sooner suspended or cancelled shall remain valid perpetually. However, the compliance with the conditions of license and provisions of the Drug and Cosmetics Act 1940 (23 of 1940) and the Drug Rules, 1945 shall be assessed not less once in five years or as needed as per risk based approach.
5. The license is issued only after fulfillment of the requirements of Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) of Ayurveda, Siddha or Unani drugs as laid down in Schedule T of the Drugs and Cosmetics Rules, 1945 "
